Highlights

Our college is going for the third cycle of NAAC reaccreditation. The reaccreditation report has been submitted and the peer team visit is scheduled from 9th March to 11th March 2015.

The Junior College Standard XII result was 99.79% while at the TYBCom, it was 86.02% which was much ahead of the overall University percentage of 65.26%.

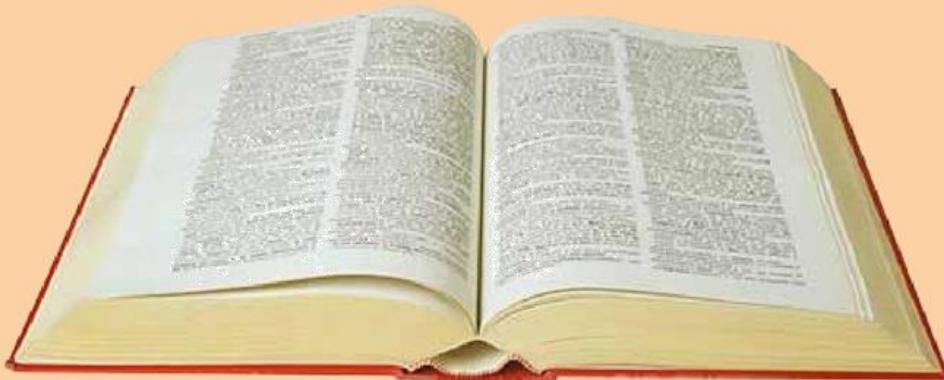
