Application for Autonomy:

Principal madam informed that application for autonomy is almost ready and will be submitted to the UGC and University of Mumbai in the first week of August, 2019. The members were requested to start educating students about autonomy. Ms. Sangeeta Kore expressed the need for conduct of some sessions on Preparation for Autonomy Process in order to upscale the knowledge about Autonomy process – benefits and responsibility. The teachers were requested to explore different syllabi and start working on up gradation of the present syllabi.

• Training for placement, Internship & Employability

employability, soft skills, Employability and life Skills.

• Career guidance

DISHA – Annual Career fair of the college should be intensified, giving career options beyond the traditional careers in the field of Commerce, Banking and finance and Information Technology.

Capacity Building

Various capacity building courses should be conducted for students, teaching and non teaching staff.

It was decided to organize the various intercollegiate festivals by different departments strictly on their core subjects and all the cultural activities should be organized in Annual Cultural Festival FANTASIES and Annual Day Celebration.
