

CODE OF ETHICS FOR RESEARCH 0 4 SEP 2020

The Code of Ethics establishes the ethical standards that must be followed by the faculty, research scholars, and students while conducting the research.

The code of Ethics shall apply to all Dissertations, Project Reports and Research Papers / Articles based thereon which are submitted by the researchers.

- 1. Researchers must practice intellectual honesty and research integrity.
- 2. Supervisors and Research Scholars should avoid research misconduct involving fabrication, falsification, or misrepresentation of research findings.
- 3. Researchers should avoid violation of publication ethics.
- 4. Researchers must follow acknowledgement and citation norms.
- 5. Research work conducted must be subjected to plagiarism check with a standard detection software.
- 6. The supervisor and the research scholar must adhere to all the guidelines issued by the University of Mumbai and UGC as amended from time to time.
