

Principal informed that the Short Term Course - Indian Ethos in Practice has been conducted for the three consecutive years and Veda chanting course has been initiated.

She highlighted that the Short Term Courses have been prepared and conducted for holistic development, skill enhancement, employability, life skills and also with emphasis on Indian culture. This will fulfill some of the requirements of NEP 2020. All courses – in house and with academic partners are framed as per college guidelines on curriculum and delivery.

She added that the STC are curated with in-house faculty and academic partners based on skills and knowledge requirement of the curriculum with the intention to bridge the gap between academics and industry.

Principal replied to Mr. Arvind Narayanan's query that 'Grow with Google' program provides placement assistance.

In response to the Principal's query on change in the syllabus, modules, title of the paper etc. Principal Parag Ajgaonkar replied that there is no such restriction on the change in the syllabi as long as workload of aided teachers remains unchanged. He also informed that they have introduced 10 new subjects. He further suggested that instead of 20 lectures of 48 minutes we can have 16 lectures of 1 hour each.

Principal further informed about on-going CSR supported courses: Diploma in Accounting Finance (supported by Tech. Mahindra), Grow with Google (by Aspire For Her Foundation)

Mr. Arvind Narayanan suggested that the in-house faculty should be trained for the Short Term Courses. While in agreement, Principal informed that some of the in-house faculty



who have upgraded their professional skills are conducting the Short Term Course and all courses are co-ordinated by in-house faculty.

He further added that the content and pedagogy had to be reviewed on a regular basis with focus on revenue generation.

Dr. D.V. Pawar appreciated the Short Term Courses introduced by the college.

Dr. Smita Shukla emphasized that NEP implementation is going to be mandatory from academic year. 23-24 batch onwards and government guidelines on four year UG degree program and NEP should be kept in mind for implementation.
