



Participants presented their opinions on the given topics. Each participant had five minutes to speak where they had to select a topic and give a speech in English.



Report of SIES INTER-COLLEGIATE DEBATE 2022-23

The SIES Inter-Collegiate Debate 2022-23 was conducted on 3rd March, 2023. The event started at 11.30 am in the presence of two judges, college Principal Dr. Nina Roy Choudhury, members of the Speakers' Forum, volunteers, participants from various colleges and a sizeable crowd. The event got Ms. Jinal Shah, a reputed academician and Mr. Harikrishnan Kurup, an academician and a published author, participants from nine colleges from in and around the city.

The topics for the debate were:

- 1) Social Media is creating a mental meltdown among users
- 2) Privatisation of Education. Boon or Bane?
- 3) Women Empowerment is a myth

The topics were given to the students well in advance and they had picked a topic of their choice.
