POLICY DOCUMENT FOR PROMOTION OF RESEARCH

Knowledge driven growth is based on innovation which is a direct outcome of searching new frontiers in our endeavors. The main purpose of research is to inform action, to prove a theory and contribute to the developing knowledge in a field of study. Research is a tool for building knowledge and for facilitating learning. The quality of research work directly translate the quality of teaching and learning in the classrooms, thereby benefitting the students and society at large.

The Institution shall implement the following to ensure a thriving research culture and environment to promote quality research

- 1. Faculty can apply to the University of Mumbai for Minor and Major Research projects as well as undertake sponsored projects from external funding agencies
- 2. Faculties should constantly participate in Research workshops and upgrade their research skills
- 3. Financial support will be available for participating in conferences, workshops and publications
- 4. Faculty can avail necessary support from the institution in terms of infrastructure, library resources, computational Facilities for implementing research projects.
- 5. Financial incentives can be availed on successful completion of research proposals/ projects/ publications
- 6. Faculty should take sole responsibility to undertake the execution of research projects
- 7. The faculty should carry out research with integrity in accordance with norms laid down by Research Advisory and Ethics Committee
- 8. The institution will be eligible for 'SIES Samshodan Puraskar' for maximum number of proposals/ articles published in a year in approved research journals
